



## SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2023-24

### K4/Pre-K (LC 1)

- 1 – jumbo 8 ct. regular Crayola Crayons
- 1 – 24 count regular Crayola crayons
- 2 - pkgs Washable Crayola classic markers
- 2 - package of glue sticks (3 count)
- 2 – pkgs. baby wipes
- 1 pkg – Ticonderoga pencils (jumbo pencils for beginning writers)
- 1 pkg – Ticonderoga #2 pencils
